

Urth Fair Isle Hats Easy Ribbing

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<u>Sizes:</u>Child (17"), Adult: Sm(19" -20"), Med(21" - 22"), Lrg(22" - 23")

Materials:

- One skein Urth "Monokrom Worsted" (100% extra fine superwash Merino, 200m 220yds, 100g 3.5oz), color 4063 (grey) or 4061 (brown) (MC/A)
- One skein Urth "Uneek Worsted" (100% extra fine superwash Merino, 200m 220yds, 100g 3.5oz), color 4004 (pinks) 4012 (greens) (CC/B)
- 16" US 5/3.5mm circular knitting needles
- 16" Size US 6/4.0mm circular knitting needles
- Set of 4 US 6/4.0mm double pointed needles
- 10 Ring stitch markers (one must be contrasting to mark beg/end of rounds)
- Yarn needle or large embroidery needle

<u>Gauge:</u> 6 sts and 7 rows to 1" with larger needles and stockinette stitch (circular gauge)

<u>Abbreviations/Terms/Techniques:</u>

Beg = Begin(ning)(s)

Cc = Contrasting color

Co = Cast on

Dpn = Double pointed needles

G = Gram(s)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together (makes decrease of 1 stitch)

Inc(s) = Increase(d)(ing)(s)

Lh = Left hand

M = Meter(s)

Mc = Main color

 $\mathbf{0z} = \mathrm{Ounce}(s)$

P = Purl

Pm = Place stitch marker on needle

Rep(s) = Repeat(ed)(ing)(s)

Rh = Right hand

Rs = Right side of knitting

S2kpo = Slip two stitches together knitwise, k1, slip two slipped stitches together over stitch just worked

S1 = Slip as if to purl: slip(ped)(ping)(s)

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise individually, insert left hand needle into the front of both of these stitches at the same time, now knit into the back of the 2 stitches as 1 (makes decrease of 1 stitch)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

W/ = With

Ws = Wrong side of knitting

X = Times

Yd(s) = Yard(s)

Catching Floats: Do not go more than 4 stitches without catching a float (I catch at 3). Insert needle into stitch first then:

To catch a right-hand float: wrap needle correctly with rh yarn, wrap needle with lh yarn and unwrap rh.

To catch a left-hand float: wrap needle backwards with lh yarn, wrap needle correctly with rh yarn and unwrap lh.

Note on Picking Yarns:

Urth Uneek is a self-striping yarn with long color ways and Monokrom is a monochromatically changing yarn. I have started working the hat with Harvest Worsted which is a pretty solid tonal and really like the look. The yarns conspire beautifully to make a faux Fair Isle where it appears you are changing yarns every two rows but it is the yarn doing all the work!

Recommended Cast on: German Twisted (AKA Old Norwegian)

Directions:

Pattern written for: Child, (Adult small, medium, large)

Beg at brim of hat

Using smaller circular needle and mc, co 96, (108, 114, 120) sts, pm and join to knit in rnds.

Ribbing: Use Mc (solid)

Rnds 1 - 5 (7, 8, 8): (K1, p1) rep to end.

All Sizes: Change to larger needles on next Round.

Size Medium Only: Use Mc (solid)

Inc Round: K10, m1, (k19, m1) 5x, k9. (120 sts)

Complete Chart for selected size or follow written instructions for that size.


Change to DPNs during decreases when needed.

Working Chart - Circular Knitting

- Complete only chart for size you are making
- Each charted row represents that row after it is worked.
- Work each rs row from right to left 8, (9, 10, 10) over each row of knitting
- Work chart from bottom to top, row by row once.

Round 4: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 32 times.

Round 6: [K1 in B, k2 in A, Count in A, k2 in A] 16 times.

Round 8: [K1 in B, k5 in A] 16 times.

Round 9: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 16 times.

Round 16: [K1 in B, k2 in A, Count in A, k2 in A] 16 times.

Round 22: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 32 times.

Round 24: [K6 in A, k1 in B, k5 in A] 8 times.

Rounds 25-26: [K1 in A, [k2 in A, k1 in B] 3 times, k2 in A] 8 times

Round 27: [K2 in A, k3 in B, [k1 in A, k1 in B] twice, k2 in B, k1 in /

Round 32: [K3 in A, [k2 in B, k1 in A] twice, k1 in A] 8 times.

Round 33: [K4 in A, k3 in B, k3 in A] 8 times.

Round 34: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k2 in A, k1 in B, k2 in A, k2tog in A] &

Round 35: [K4 in A, k1 in B, k3 in A] 8 times.


Round 37: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k3 in A, k2tog in A] 8 times.

Round 40: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k1 in A, k2tog in A] 8 times.


Round 43: [K1 in A, s2tog-k1-p2sso in A] 8 times.

Round 44: K2tog 8 times in A.

Adult Size Small




Written Instructions for Adult Size Small Chart




Adult Size Medium





Round 1: K120 in A (120 sts). Round 2: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts).

Round 3: K120 in B (120 sts).

Round 4: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts).

Round 5: K120 in A (120 sts).

Round 6: [K1 in B, k2 in A, Count in A, k2 in A] 20 times (120 sts). Round 7: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 20 times (120 sts).

Rounds 8-9: Repeat rows 6-7.

Round 10: [K1 in A, k2 in B] 40 times (120 sts).

Round 11: [K2 in A, k3 in B, k1 in A] 20 times (120 sts). Round 12: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts)

Round 13: [K2 in A, k3 in B, k1 in A] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 14: [K1 in A, k2 in B] 40 times (120 sts).

Round 15: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 16: [K1 in B, k2 in A, Count in A, k2 in A] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 17: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 18: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts)

Round 19: [K2 in A, k3 in B, k1 in A] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 20: [K1 in A, k2 in B] 40 times (120 sts)

Round 21: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 22: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts)

Round 23: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 24: [K1 in A, k2 in B] 40 times (120 sts) Round 25: [K2 in A, k3 in B, k1 in A] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 26: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts).

Round 36: [K1 in B, k2 in A, Count in A, k2 in A] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 37: [K2 in B, k3 in A, k1 in B] 20 times (120 sts).

Round 38: [K1 in B, k2 in A] 40 times (120 sts).

Round 39: [K1 in A, [k2 in A, k1 in B] 3 times, k2 in A] 10 times (120 sts).

Round 40: [K2 in A, k3 in B, [k1 in A, k1 in B] twice, k2 in B, k1 in A] 10 times (120 sts).

Round 41: [[K1 in A, k2 in B] twice, k3 in B, k1 in A, k2 in B] 10 times (120 sts)

Round 42: [K2 in A, k3 in B, [k1 in A, k1 in B] twice, k2 in B, k1 in A] 10 times (120 sts).

Round 43: [K1 in A, [k2 in A, k1 in B] 3 times, k2 in A] 10 times (120 sts). Round 44: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k2 in A, k3 in B, k2 in A, k2tog in A] 10 times (100 sts).

Round 45: [K3 in A, [k2 in B, k1 in A] twice, k1 in A] 10 times (100 sts).

Round 46: [K4 in A, k3 in B, k3 in A] 10 times (100 sts).

Round 47: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k2 in A, k1 in B, k2 in A, k2tog in A] 10 times (80 sts).

Round 48: [K4 in A, k1 in B, k3 in A] 10 times (80 sts).

Round 49: K80 in A (80 sts).

Round 50: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k3 in A, k2tog in A] 10 times (60 sts).

Rounds 51-52: K60 in A (60 sts). Round 53: [K1 in A, ssk in A, k1 in A, k2tog in A] 10 times (40 sts).

Rounds 54-55: K40 in A (40 sts).

Round 56: [K1 in A, s2tog-k1-p2sso in A] 10 times (20 sts).

Round 57: K2tog 10 times in A (10 sts).

Finishing

Cut yarn leaving an 8 inch tail. With darning needle, pull yarn through stitches in the same order you would have knit them. Pull tight to close the hole and weave in end on inside of hat.

The hat will benefit from light blocking.

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
